Ans: <u>Iman:</u> The Almighty Allah is one. He has no partner. Only He is our Ma'bud. Hazrat Muhammad (Sm) Allah's Nabi and Rasul. To believe these all with heart and soul is called Iman.

(d) What does 'Allahu Khaliqun' mean?

Ans: Khaliq means the Creator. Allahu Khaliqun means Allah is the creator. He is the creator of everything.

(e) What trouble would happen if we had no hands?

Ans: If we had no hands, we could not catch anything. We could not eat food properly. We could not play. Moreover, we could be incomplete.

(f) What does 'Razzaq' mean?

Ans: Razzaq means food / riziq provider. Allahu Razzaqun means Allah is the riziq / food provider.

(g) What does the word 'Rab' mean?

Ans: Rab means the cherisher. Allahu Rabbun means – Allah is the Cherisher.

h) What does "Rabbul Alamin" mean?

Ans.: The Almighty Allah is not only our Rab. He is Rabbul A'lameen. He is the Cherisher of all the creatures. We shall obey Allah as our Cherisher.

i) Why has Allah Ta'ala created human beings?

Ans: The Almighty Allah has created human beings for His Ibadat and obeying His order. We must believe in Allah and worship Him

j) What do we say when we utter the name of our prophet?

Ans.: We say "Sallallahu Alaihi Wa - Sallam" when we utter the name of our prophet.

k) What is Sahifa?

Ans: Sahifa: There are one hundred and four Asmani Kitabs. Among the kitabs four are big in size. And the remaining one Hundred are small in size. These small sized kitabs are called Sahifa.

(a) How does Allah cherish us?

Ans: Allah cherishes us. Allah Ta'ala cherishes us by giving light, air and water. He has given us different kinds of fruits, crops, vegetables, fishes and animals. We live on all these. The Almighty Allah is not only our Rab. He is Rabbul A'lameen. He is the cherisher of all creatures.

(b) Why is no food compared with the milk of mother?

Ans: The one and only food for a new born child is mother's milk. The almighty Allah has arranged milk in the breast of a mother before the birth of a child. No food is comparable with mother's milk. Mother's milk needs neither water, sugar, feeder and nor anything else. There is no trouble of making it too.

(c) From which do trees and vegetable take food?

Ans.: Trees and vegetables are made their own food. They take food from light, air and soil. Light, air and soil are the gifts of Allah. All live on the Riziq provided by Allah.

(d) What is Asmani Kitab?

Ans: Hazrat Jibrail (A), Allah's angel, used to bring the messages of Allah to the prophets and messengers. The collection of these massages is called Kitab. This Kitab is also called Asmani Kitab or heavenly book. Asmani Kitabs are 104 in number. Among them 4 are big in size and 100 in small in size.

(e) What is Akhirat?

Ans: Human beings are born on this earth. They lead a life here. After a period of time human beings die. The life after death is called 'Akhirat'. Akhirat means hereafter. Akhirat has beginning. It has no ending. There is some stages in the life of Akhirat.

They are the grave, Qiyamat, Hashar, Judgment, Jannat and Jahannam.
